## Design Summary

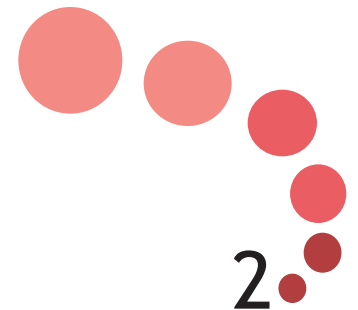

## Audience Profile

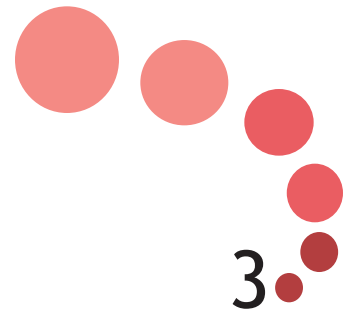
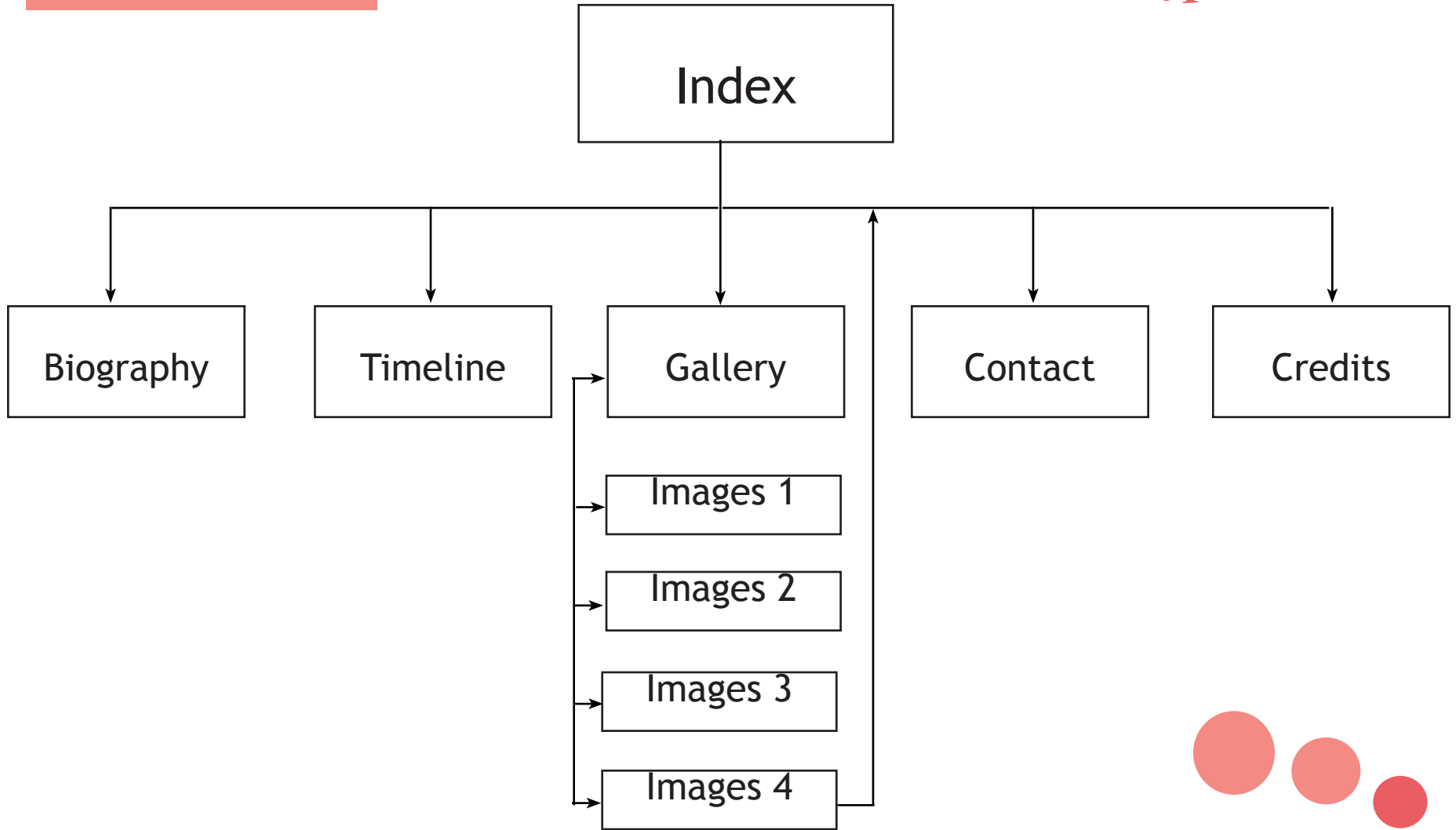
